163531 - Monument to Antonio Giuriolo - Corona - Lizzano in Belvedere

Stone monument with profile of Antonio Giuriolo, laurel branch, memorial inscription, fountain.

The monument is dedicated to Captain Antonio Giuriolo (1912-1944), commander of the Matteotti Montagna partisan Brigade from July 1944 until his death. Giuriolo was killed in Corona of Lizzano in Belvedere on the 12th dicember 1944 in a firefight against the Germans.

In Corona there are four "memory stones " that ommemorate Giuriolo and the Matteotti Montagna partisan Brigade, by configuring a dedicated memorial area. They are located along the provincial road 66 which from Querciola rises towards Corona, distributed over about 200 meters starting from the road sign for Corona. Successively we come across: the commemorative of the visit of the Republic President Carlo Azeglio Ciampi in 2001 and the memorial stone dedicated to Giuriolo at the place where he fell fighting together with his comrade. ; the stele dedicated to Matteotti Montagna partisan Brigade Corpo Volontari della Libertà; the monument to Giuriolo surveyed in this card. For the history of Giuriolo and the Matteotti Montagna Partisan Brigade, and the other "stones of remembrance " that in the municipalities of Alto Reno Terme and Lizzano in Belvedere have the same commemorative intent, look at this portal for "Stele for Antonio Giuriolo commemoration", "Monument to captain 'Tony' and the fallen partisans " and the attached "in the footsteps of the Matteotti
